

Age: from 10 and older

Players: 2 and more

What do you need? A camera

This is how it works:

It's the same as with other memory games: *you have to find pairs.*

To make your 'feeling-memory' you and your friends discuss some feelings in the group. Take photos of each other with different feelings (e.g. big smile for feeling happy, unhappy face for feeling sad,...) To show your feelings you can use your face or your whole body. Get the films developed and ask for 2 reprints. When you get the photos stick them on cards – make sure all of them have the same size. Now you can start the game!

You put the cards on the table so the photos face the table. Every player is allowed to pick up two cards. Once you find two of the same kind you can keep the pair and you can continue looking for more. As soon as the cards look different the next player can pick up two cards. The end is when there are no cards left that face the table.

The winner is the one with most of the pairs.
